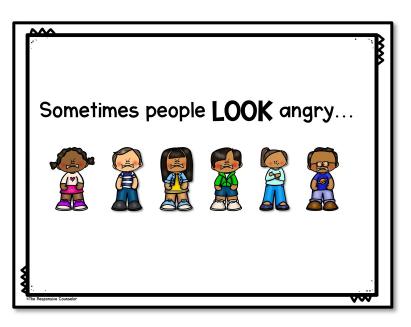
Both sets of slides are also uploaded onto Google Slides IM. They will be on the second page of the lesson plan PDF file.

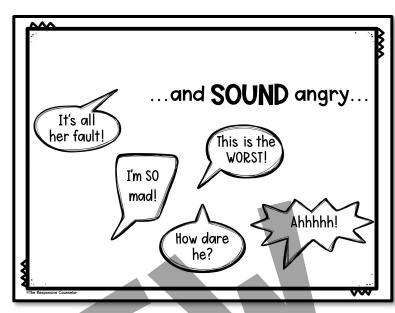
#### NOTES FOR THE COUNSELOR:

This resource teaches students to recognize the feelings that lie beneath anger. It's helpful for self-awareness and awareness of others. Use it as a center in classroom lessons, in small group sessions, or with individual counseling.

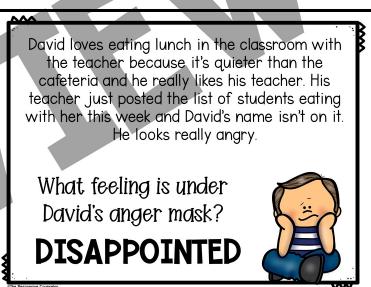
- For individual or small group counseling, make resource into a file folder activity. "Uncover" the feelings under each anger mask, talk through some of the scenarios (using the large or small task cards), then create your own scenario.
- For whole class lessons, use the PowerPoint to introduce the concept and practice 6 examples all together. Then give student pairs or groups 10 more example cards to work through together (put the tracking sheet in a dry erase pocket to use over ad over). Exit ticket and worksheet also included.
  - For a center in classroom lessons, use the file folder with the 6 larger scenarios for each group to work through.
